What Is Get Kids Ready?

Get Kids Ready is a free school-readiness program for eligible 4-year-olds. Children build skills for kindergarten through purposeful play, hands-on exploration, stories, music, movement, art, early math, science, and meaningful social experiences. Our curriculum is aligned with the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards (WMELS).

What Children Will Practice

- Early language, literacy, and communication
- Beginning math, problem-solving, and critical thinking
- Social-emotional skills, friendships, and cooperation
- Independence, confidence, and classroom routines
- Creativity, fine-motor development, and physical movement

Who Is Eligible?

A child must be 4 years old by September 1, 2026, and must not be enrolled in K5 during the 2026–2027 school year. Final eligibility and enrollment are confirmed by the program.

Parent/Guardian Requirements

- Complete all required enrollment, health, emergency, and permission forms.
- Support regular attendance and notify the program when your child will be absent.
- Ensure your child arrives on time and is prepared to participate each day.
- Complete requested developmental screenings and participate in fall and spring conferences.
- Keep contact, emergency, and authorized-pickup information current.
